MONTAUK FISHING BY SEASON - FALL

The fall marks the return of striped bass inshore, as schools migrating down the coast from Maine, Massachusetts, and northern waters will round Montauk Point en route back to their winter spawning grounds. October and November can be outstanding months to find big schools of stripers pushing baitfish like sand eels and peanut bunker right into the beaches at Montauk Point.

The fall is also a great time to catch other game fish, including false albacore, also feeding on sand eels along beaches in September and October.

When the water is especially clear, target areas with steep drop-offs, and you might also catch bonito.

Deep-sea fishing runs to the canyons for tuna will continue beyond summer into October. As conditions warm, these fish hang around later, with tuna caught off-shore into December in recent years.


